Review of Petroleum Pump Prices for January 2026

In December 2025, the Zambian Kwacha appreciated by 3.13% against the US dollar, moving from an opening rate of K23.24/US\$ and closing at a rate of K22.52/US\$. Further, the international oil prices generally decreased since the last fuel price review on 30th November 2025. Following this movement, the Energy Regulation Board (ERB) has revised downwards the pump prices for Diesel, Kerosene, and Jet A-1 to K25.11/ litre, K23.88/litre and K25.53/litre, respectively. The pump price for Petrol will be maintained at K29.92/litre as the change in the wholesale prices did not exceed the 2.5% trigger band.

The new pump prices for January 2026 are as indicated below:

The Posted Airfield Prices at International Airports for January 2026 are shown below:

The prices come into effect at midnight on 31st December 2025 and shall remain in effect until revised by the ERB.
