

Review of Petroleum Pump Prices for September 2025

Since the last fuel price review on 31st July 2025, the Kwacha depreciated against the United States Dollar by 2.50%, from K23.23/US\$ to K23.81/US\$. On the Tanzanian Bulk Procurement System (BPS), premiums for petrol increased by 17.27% from US\$132.45/MT to US\$155.33/MT, while Kerosene and Jet A-I increased by 3.16% from US\$190.00/MT to US\$196.00/MT. Under the TAZAMA Open Access framework, diesel premiums remained stable.

Meanwhile, the international prices marginally declined with petrol reducing by 0.35%, from US\$74.58/bbl to US\$74.32/bbl. Diesel declined by 2.81% from US\$86.70/bbl to US\$84.26/bbl, while the price of Kerosene/Jet A-I reduced by 1.48% from US\$83.27/bbl to US\$82.04/bbl.

The combined effect of the depreciation of the Kwacha against the United States Dollar and the increase in petroleum products premiums outweighed the impact of the decline in international oil prices affecting the September 2025 domestic price review.

Based on the foregoing, the Energy Regulation Board (ERB) has revised the pump prices of Petrol, Diesel, Kerosene and Jet A-I for the month of September 2025. The pump prices for petroleum products shall be K29.18/litre for Petrol, K25.05/litre for Diesel, K23.64/litre and K25.83/litre, for Kerosene and Jet A-I.

Pump prices for September 2025 are as indicated below.
